ROHS Statement

America II is an independent distributor of electronic components and does not manufacture any of the components that it sells. Accordingly, America II is unable to represent or certify to our customers what materials are used in the manufacturing process of the components we provide for resale. America II is aware of the ROHS compliance mandate that became effective July 1, 2006, the additional mandate concerning decaBDE that became effective July 1st 2008 and has gathered information about manufacturers and manufacturer's web sites that may be useful to customers in determining component compliance. Information may include product status, dates of product compliance and data that may be available from the manufacturer to document compliance. As the process moves forward, websites and manufacturers' information provided to customers by America II are intended as possible research vehicles so customers may complete their due diligence and do not represent in any way a certification by America II as to the chemical content of any component. Chemicals used in the components or the manufacturing of the components are selected and used at the sole discretion of the manufacturer and in many cases will be considered intellectual property. Certification of any chemical content is the sole responsibility of the manufacturer. America II does not add any of the ROHS substances during its handling process of electronics components.

America II does certify that it will ship the manufacturer, the part number and meet any date code restrictions as they appear on your purchase order. Upon request, America II will supply to the buyer, information if available that a component may or may not be ROHS compliant according to the manufacturer's web site or data sheet.
